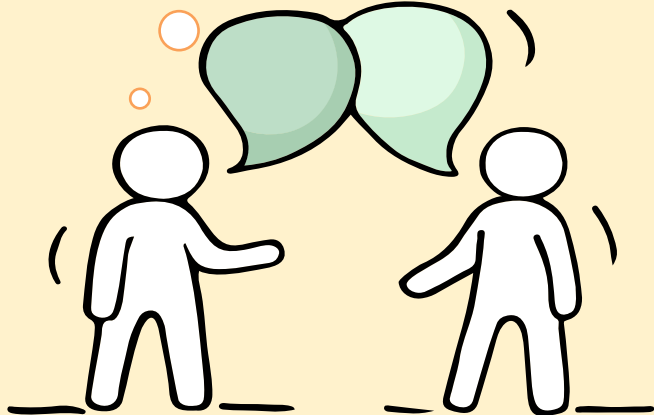

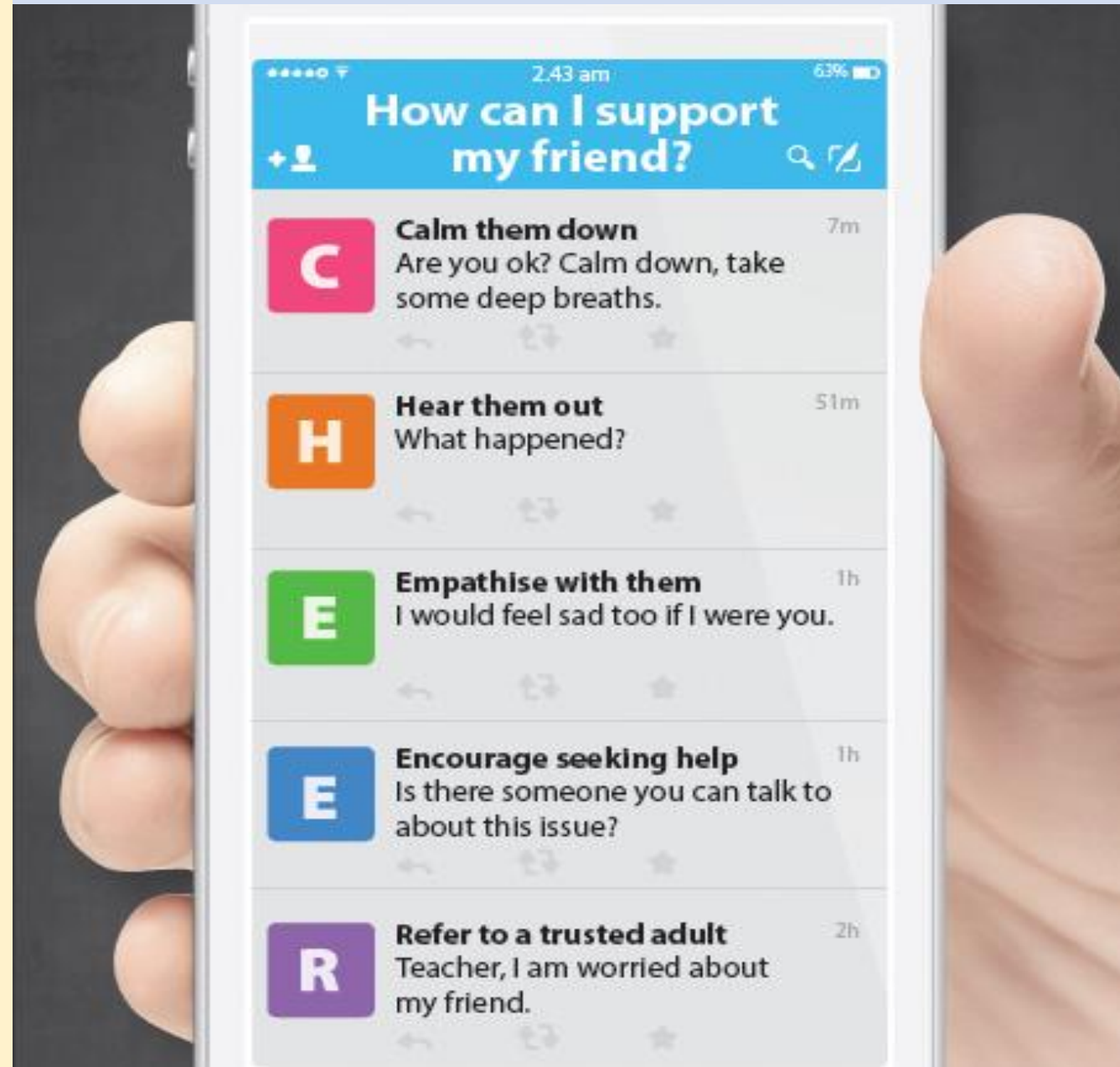


Supporting Your Friend

1. You will receive an email on your JAE eligibility. If you meet the eligibility criteria, you will also receive **Form A**, containing the courses for which you qualify to apply.
2. Use the JAE worksheet as a guide to choose up to 12 courses from Form A. Make sure to list them in the order of your preference.
3. Submit your application through the JAE Internet System (JAE-IS) using your Singpass during the application period.
4. Once you have successfully submitted your application, you will receive a **verification slip through the email address**

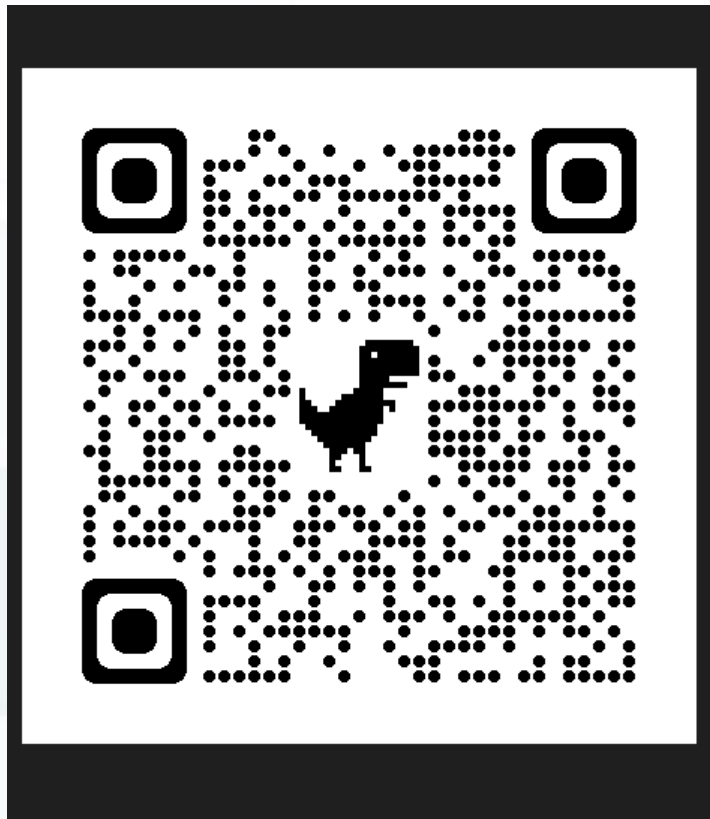

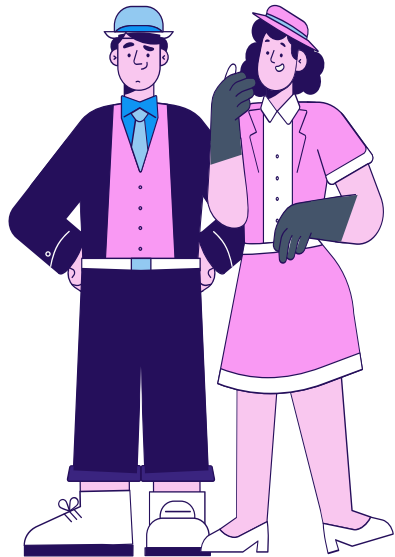

How To Apply?

- 1) Consider your strengths, interest, various pathways
- 2) Meet eligibility criteria and grade requirements for specific subjects
E.g. JC
 - L1R5 less than 20 points
 - English: Grade 1-6
 - E OR A Maths: Grade 1-7
 - MTL: Grad 1-7 / HMTL: Grade 1-8E.g. Poly
 - ELR2B2 less than 26 points for poly diplomas or 28 points for Poly Nursing
 - English: Grade 1-4 for Law & Management Diploma
- 3) Rank your course choices

Important Information

- Student to submit 12 course choices, a mix of JC / Poly / ITE 2-Year Higher Nitec courses
- **1st choice course is important as it has impact on your posting.**

What if you are not posted to any of your chosen courses? 

You will be allocated a course of the same institution type as your first choice, subject to available vacancies and for which you met the course's entry requirements.

For example, if you have indicated JC as your first choice, you will be allocated to a JC course with vacancy.

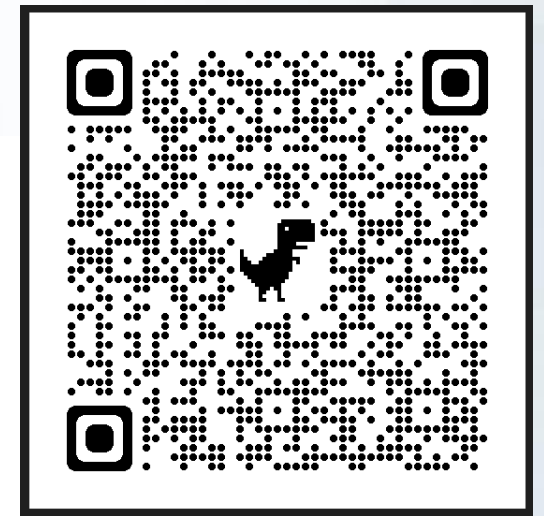


How posting works?

To apply for a course, you must first meet the [admission criteria](#) of the course.

After eligibility is confirmed, all these factors will be taken into consideration for posting.

1. Your net aggregate score, that is gross aggregate score minus bonus points.
2. Your choice of courses.
3. Vacancies available in the courses.

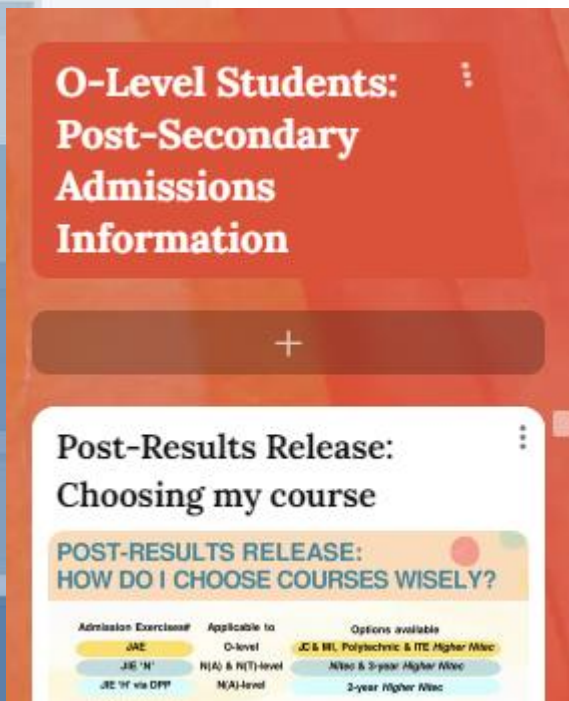

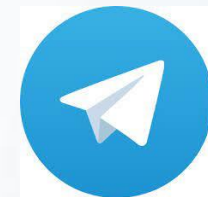
